ORDINANCE 2006-17

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHATHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, VACATING THE RIGHT OF WAY FOR A PORTION OF
STAFFORD ROAD**

WHEREAS, a portion of the westerly side of Stafford Road in the Township of Chatham in front of 5 Stafford Road (Block 48.06, Lot 12) and 9 Stafford Road (Block 48.06, Lot 13) contained a cul de sac as shown on Map No. 2739, filed on January 24, 1967 in the Morris County Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, Stafford Road is a through street connecting Glenmere Drive to Thornley Drive with no need for a cul de sac; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Map, which is the official map of the Township of Chatham, does not show the cul de sac, and, in fact, the cul de sac does not physically exist; and

WHEREAS, the Township has no need for said cul de sac in the street right of way and it appearing that the public interest will be better served by vacating said portion of the street right of way;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Chatham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the cul de sac portion of Stafford Road as shown in Map No. 2739, filed January 24, 1967, in the Morris County Clerk's Office as it appears in front of 5 Stafford Road (Block 48.06, Lot 12) and 9 Stafford Road (Block 48.06, Lot 13), is hereby vacated in its entirety and the portions thereof divided and conveyed to the adjoining property owners in accordance with law so that the westerly sideline

of Stafford Road shall be as shown on page 47 of the Tax Map of the Township of Chatham.

2. All rights and privileges possessed by public utilities, as defined by R. S. 48:2-13, and by any cable television company, as defined in the Cable Television Act, P.L. 1972, c.186 (N.J.S.A. 48:5A-1 et seq.) to maintain, repair and replace facilities, in, adjacent to, over or under Stafford Road, are hereby expressly reserved from vacation.
3. The Mayor and Township Clerk are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary to effectuate such purpose.
3. This ordinance shall take effect and be recorded in the Office of the Morris County Clerk in accordance with law.
